**Concerning:** We are requesting permission to move the South Hero Inn Honeymoon Cabin from the Kinney Farm to the blacktop directly behind (north) of the greenspace which is west of The Old White Meeting House.

- Placing the cabin in this location not only preserves the greenspace as greenspace but also enhances the esthetics by providing a pleasant backdrop for community activities while not taking over the greenspace.
- Support for “Saving the Cabin” has been received both in monetary form and in volunteer enthusiasm. This is enabling us to create an endowment for perpetual care of the restored cabin.
- Placing the Cabin here enhances this part of town as an historical center with the museum across the street and the old White Meeting House next door.
