- 1. Funding Secured:
  - \$500,000 Northern Borders Grant
  - \$150,000 Voter allocation
  - \$100,000 Obligated ARPA funds
  - \$100,000 Bruhn Grant
  - \$50,000 Minimum donation from South Hero Foundation
  - \$20,000 VT Historic Preservation Grant
  - \$920,000
- 2. Pending Funding: \$400,000 Save America's Treasures Grant. Requires passage of the 2025 Federal Budget.
- 3. Brownfields Lead Issue: Soil samples outside the building yielded levels of lead above those accepted by the State. waiting for a letter from the State about what is required.
- 4. Build Committee has reviewed and recommended the 75% architects plans sent to the National Park Service be accepted by the Committee and the Selectboard. Upon hearing the plans require no further changes as a result of NPS review the architects at Arnold & Scangas will complete the plans and write up specs. Final plans will have to again go to the NPS for final review.
- 5. Bid period is expected to be late winter. Next will be contractors identified, contracts negotiated etc. and ready for active work to begin spring 2025.
- 6. Fund-raising will continue through the South Hero Foundation.
